Green to Grow's Bottles to Babies Initiative

2009 was a year of giving for Green to Grow. Although the economic downturn presented some formidable challenges, we recognized our commitment to social responsibility was more important than ever. Rather than decreasing our efforts to give back, we strengthened them. We had the pleasure and privilege of working with California senator Fran Pavley, Assemblywoman Fiona Ma, Environmental Working Group, Breast Cancer Fund, and Physicians for Social Responsibility on SB 797 — a bill to ban BPA in products for children under the age of three. In support of SB 797, Green to Grow donated \$19,000 in BPA-free baby bottles to non-profit organizations that serve low-income families in California. Our efforts to reach economically disadvantaged families extended beyond California to Oregon, Massachusetts, New York, and Africa. **In total, Green to Grow donated over \$52,000 of BPA-free baby bottles to non-profit organizations that serve families in need.** We recognize our efforts have been supported by our esteemed partners, who have brought the Green to Grow brand, vision, and commitment to parents and children worldwide. We have immense gratitude for this support and we look forward to continuing and expanding our commitment to families in 2010.
